The Labourer (Plasma Table) is responsible for assisting the Plasma Table Operator to produce a high quality product in a safe and efficient manner. This includes, but is not limited to, handling material (manual and with cranes or forklifts), finished parts clean up, identifying and storage of parts and unused materials. The Labourer will be required to ascend/descend stairs multiple times per shift, lift and carry small parts frequently, and be exposed to outside weather conditions occasionally.

Job Duties

- Responsible for working in accordance with OH&S regulations, JNE safe work procedures, ISO procedures, and JNE Values/Code of Conduct.
- Load raw material onto the Plasma Table for processing.
- Unload parts from Plasma Table either manually or with the overhead crane.
- Inspect to ensure parts are of high quality, clean parts with a grinder, if necessary.
- Sort finished parts, and identify the parts with a metal marker.
- Deliver the parts to the designated user or area.
- Return unused material to the proper storage area.
- Clean the shop and table area.
- Assist in other areas, or shops when requested.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Grade 10 with math.
- Excellent attention to detail.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills.
- Able to follow written and verbal instruction (good understanding of English).
