- Interpret drawings and weld symbols and organize workspace and equipment.
- Understand schedule requirements and perform work efficiently to meet schedule and estimates.
- Fabricate, fit, and tack fabrications according to specifications and drawings. Verify the consumable, shielding gas, and welding parameters of the welding equipment in relation to the weld specification of each weld.
- Weld fabrications.
- Material handling and moving of finished product.
- Responsible use of consumables and raw materials.
- Final verification of dimensions and weld preps on the fabrications prior to Quality Assurance checking the fabrication and identifying that it is ready to weld.

The ideal candidate will have the following qualifications and experience:

- Graduate of Pre-employment Welding program or an Apprentice Steel Fabricator (proven equivalent training and/or experience will be considered)
- Ability to interpret drawings, weld symbols, and weld procedure data sheets
